### **Day-to-day details of programme**

**Sunday 3 January – Friday 22 January 2010**

#### **Day 1 – Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> January**

Arrival. : you will have access to your room in the hostel (Mije) after 3 pm but can leave your luggage earlier.

#### **Day 2 – Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30 Meeting with Annie and David Bancroft in the Mije.

9h30-12h : Greeting, presentation of the programme, of the aims and techniques.

12h30 Welcome get-together lunch.

Afternoon : guided bus tour to introduce the students on how to use buses and metro in Paris

Late afternoon: a cruise on the Seine on a *bateau mouche*.

#### **Day 3 – Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30-12h : in the Mije.

Theme No. 1 : ***FOOD and SHOPS.***

Afternoon : guided visit to a supermarket with a questionnaire to introduce the students on how to use the questionnaires to maximum advantage.

Then visit a department store with another questionnaire.

#### **Day 4 – Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30 : meet in an open street market with questionnaire.

List of special shops to choose from with different questionnaires .

Afternoon : after choosing the special shop(s) students are interested in , visit with questionnaire(s).

#### **Day 5 – Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30-12h : in the Mije.

1- Checking the Tuesday and Wednesday questionnaires.

2- Theme No.2 : ***WHAT IS LEFT OF ROMAN, MEDIEVAL & RENAISSANCE PARIS***

Afternoon : visit the crypt of Notre Dame, then Notre Dame cathedral itself, followed by the Cluny medieval museum with questionnaires.

### **Day 6 – Friday 8<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30 : meet in front of the *Sainte-Chapelle* for a guided visit followed by the *Conciergerie* (with questionnaires).

Afternoon : visit the *Louvre* with questionnaire.

### **Day 7 – Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30-12h : in the Mije.

1- Checking the Thursday and Friday questionnaires.

2- Theme No.2 : **WHAT YOU CAN SEE OF 17<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> century PARIS.**

Afternoon : guided visit of *Le Marais* with questionnaire

### **Day 8 – Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> January : FREE**

### **Day 9 – Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30 : meet in front of *St Germain des Prés* church for a guided walk through the Faubourg Saint Germain to discover Paris of the 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries.(questionnaire)

Afternoon : visit the *Musée Rodin* and the *Invalides* with questionnaires.

### **Day 10 – Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30-12h : in Mije

1- Checking Saturday and Monday questionnaires.

2- Theme No. 4 : **FROM IMPRESSIONISM TO 20<sup>th</sup> CENTURY ART.IN FRANCE**

Afternoon : guided visit of the *Orsay Museum* with questionnaire.

### **Day 11 – Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30 : meet at the bottom of the *funiculaire* for a guided walking tour of **Montmartre** (questionnaire)

Afternoon : visit either the *Musée de l'Orangerie*, or the *Musée Marmottan-Claude Monet*, or the *Musée Picasso*. (questionnaire)

### **Day 12 – Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> January**

All day in **Versailles** with guided visit and questionnaire.

### **Day 13 – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30-12h : in Mije.

1-Checking the Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday questionnaires.

2- Theme No. 5 : **PRESS, MEDIA, ADVERTISING**

Group work : to present either one newspaper or a magazine, or advertisement in the press, metro, streets.

Afternoon : visit *Pompidou Centre* with questionnaire.

### **Day 14 – Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30-12h : in Mije

1- Checking the questionnaire and follow-up presentations on the media.

2- Theme No. 6 : **FASHION (Male & Female!) and JEWELRY.**

Afternoon : choice of walks with questionnaire :

- Place Vendôme, Rue de la Paix
- Rue de Sèvres, rue du Four, Bd Saint Germain
- Rue du Faubourg Saint Honoré, rue Royale, Place de la Madeleine
- Le Forum des Halles.

**Day 15 – Sunday 17th January : FREE!**

**Day 16 – Monday 18th January**

9h30-12h : in Mije

- 1- Checking the Saturday questionnaires.
- 2- Theme No. 7 : **FRENCH DECORATIVE ARTS**
- 3- How to choose a museum or a different part of Paris you'd like to visit.

Afternoon : guided visit of the *Jacquemart-André* Museum (questionnaire)

**Day 17 – Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> January**

9h30 : meet at the Mije for a guided bus, metro and walking tour.

Theme No. 8 : **THE CHANGING FACE OF PARIS IN THE 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> CENTURIES** (with questionnaire)

Afternoon : Guided visit of the *Père Lachaise* cemetery : national historic monument, park, and one of the most visited places in Paris! A Park of Remembrance for many great historical figures

**Day 18 – Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> January**

Morning : visit of the museum (s) or part of Paris you have chosen. (Presentation to the rest of the group after the visit)

Afternoon : visit either the *Musée des Arts Décoratifs* or the *Musée Cognacq-Jay* (questionnaire)

**Day 19 – Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> January**

9h30-12h : in Mije

- 1- Checking Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday questionnaires
- 2- Presentation of the chosen museums and/or parts of Paris.
- 3- Very short personal account of your month in Paris

Afternoon : free

Evening : Farewell dinner
